Rationale

There is a strong correlation between school attendance and academic success. CAIS believes that parents, students, and school staff have a shared responsibility to ensure that students attend school in accordance with this policy and legislative requirements.

Guidelines

- 1. Students shall attend school regularly and punctually when the school is open for instruction.
- 2. Students shall attend additional learning opportunities as directed by staff such as, but not limited to, after-school catch-up sessions and detentions.
- 3. Students are not permitted to leave school grounds during the school day, with the exception of those with an approved valid reason, or Grade 12 students during lunchtime.
- 4. A student is only excused from attending school on a day on which the school is open if:
 - 4.1. The student is unable to attend by reason of sickness or other unavoidable cause; or
 - 4.2. There is a death or critical illness in the family; or
 - 4.3. The absence has been approved in advance by a senior leader.



- 5. The school shall communicate the school's Attendance Policy to students, parents/guardians, and teachers at the start of each school year.
- 6. Students are expected to make up all missed work associated with excused and unexcused absences.
- 7. The teacher shall refer to a senior leader, all cases of excessive absences for which satisfactory explanation is not obtained; and all cases for which absences have contributed to slow academic progress.
- 8. The Senior Leader shall arrange a conference with the student and parents to discuss the situation.
