Rationale

So that CAIS can assess the quality and effectiveness of education provided to students, and to improve student learning, apart from its own measures, students in Grades 3, 6, 9 and 12 shall sit the appropriate Provincial Assessments.

Procedures

1. Students in the appropriate grades sit the relevant Provincial Assessment Tests:
 - Grade 3: Student Learning Assessment (SLA)
 - Grades 6 & 9: Provincial Assessment Tests (PAT)
 - Grade 12: Diploma Examinations
2. Senior Leaders and Team Leaders analyse and review student results at an individual student level, at a class level, as a grade level and by gender.
3. Results are shared with relevant staff including classroom teachers, team leaders and learning support staff.
4. Individual Education Plans are prepared or adjusted for relevant students.
5. Adjustments are made to courses depending on the analysis of results.
6. Results are reported to parents as individual results for their child; to the school community in cohort summary form.
