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CAIS Celebrates Two Perfect Scores and Outstanding 2025 IB Diploma Results

Christian Alliance International School (CAIS) is pleased to announce remarkable International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) results and university acceptances of the Class of 2025, the largest graduating cohort at CAIS to date.

This year's IBDP cohort achieved an impressive average score of 37.3 points with a 100% pass rate. Notably, two students, Tinkie Chan and Ian Ma, attained a perfect score of 45 points. A summary of the Class of 2025's results is as follows:

- 2 students received the maximum score of 45 points
- 31% scored over 40 points
- 62% scored over 35 points
- 100% pass rate
- An average score of 37.3 points

This year celebrates the third IBDP cohort since CAIS was accredited as an IB World School in 2020. The IB Diploma Year 1 Programme was offered to Grade 11 students starting from the academic year 2021/22 and onward and the Diploma Year 2 Programme for Grade 12 students from 2022/23 and onward. With 13 IBDP candidates this year, the steady growth and remarkable accomplishments seen today are truly a testament to the commitment and academic excellence of CAIS and its students. In 2025, CAIS successfully completed its first 5-year IB Evaluation by the IB Organization, receiving highly positive comments that affirm the school's commitment to nurturing inquiring, knowledgeable, and caring young learners.

Departing Head of School, Mr. Richard Vanderpyl remarks, "The IB Diploma Programme at CAIS, now in its third year, has already proven to be a strong and successful academic pathway. Achieving two perfect scores so early in the programme's history highlights its strength and the dedication of both students and faculty." He congratulates Tinkie and Ian, saying, "These two outstanding students have not only excelled academically but have also made significant contributions to the school and wider community through their active participation in various extracurricular and service initiatives."

With their outstanding academic results and graduate profiles, CAIS students have gained recognition from universities worldwide. This year's graduates have received offers from distinguished institutions including the University of Toronto, McGill University, The University of British Columbia, King's College London, University of Bristol, University of California San Diego, The University of Hong Kong, and The Chinese University of Hong Kong, among others.



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The offers above span a diverse range of fields such as accounting, applied science, architecture, fine art, international relations, kinesiology, law, mechanical engineering, medicine, medical science, occupational therapy, public health, psychology, zoology, and more.

Established in 2017 at its current site at Butterfly Valley, CAIS is uniquely positioned as it offers three education pathways for students, including the Alberta (Canada) curriculum, IB Diploma Programme, and Advanced Placement courses. Currently only two other international schools in the world have received this status.
